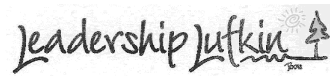
COMMUNITY SERVICE

Leadership Tomorrow graduates should strive to continue their leadership training through the Leadership Lufkin program, upon meeting the qualifications.

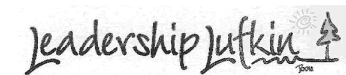


HOW TO JOIN

During the designated time, applications are available at counselors’ offices at Angelina County high schools, the Lufkin/Angelina County Chamber of Commerce, or on line at www.leadershiptomorrowlufkin.com. All applications must have written approval of a parent or guardian, and high school principal or counselor and returned to the Chamber during the designated application period.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ Applicant must be entering his or her junior year in high school or home school.
- ◆ Applicant must have a desire to develop leadership skills.
- ◆ Applicant must have transportation to and from the sessions on the dates indicated.
- ◆ Applicant must pay \$60 fee in full upon acceptance and secure a sponsor whose fee will be \$150.
